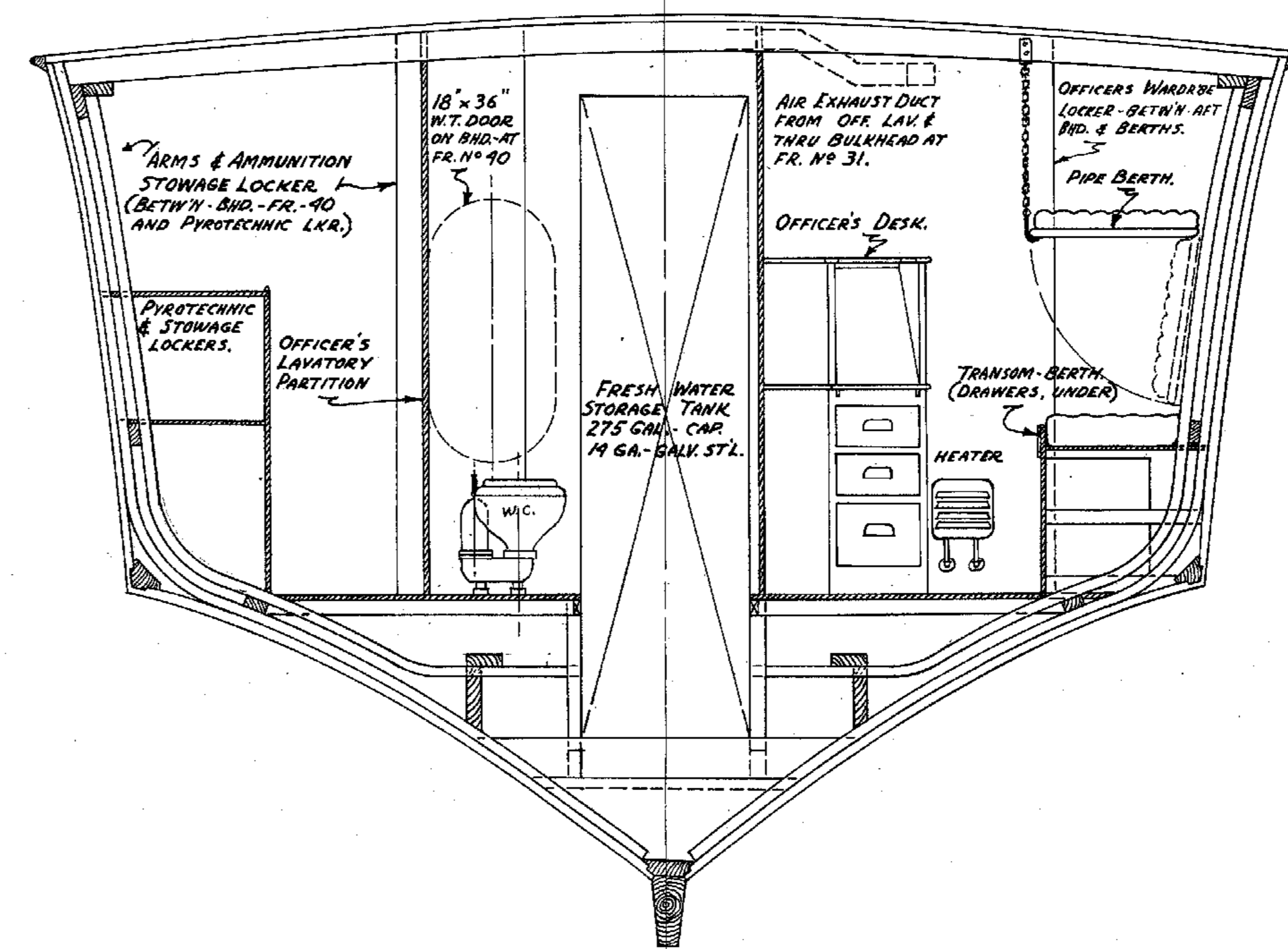
SECTION AT FRAME No 7
LOOKING AFT



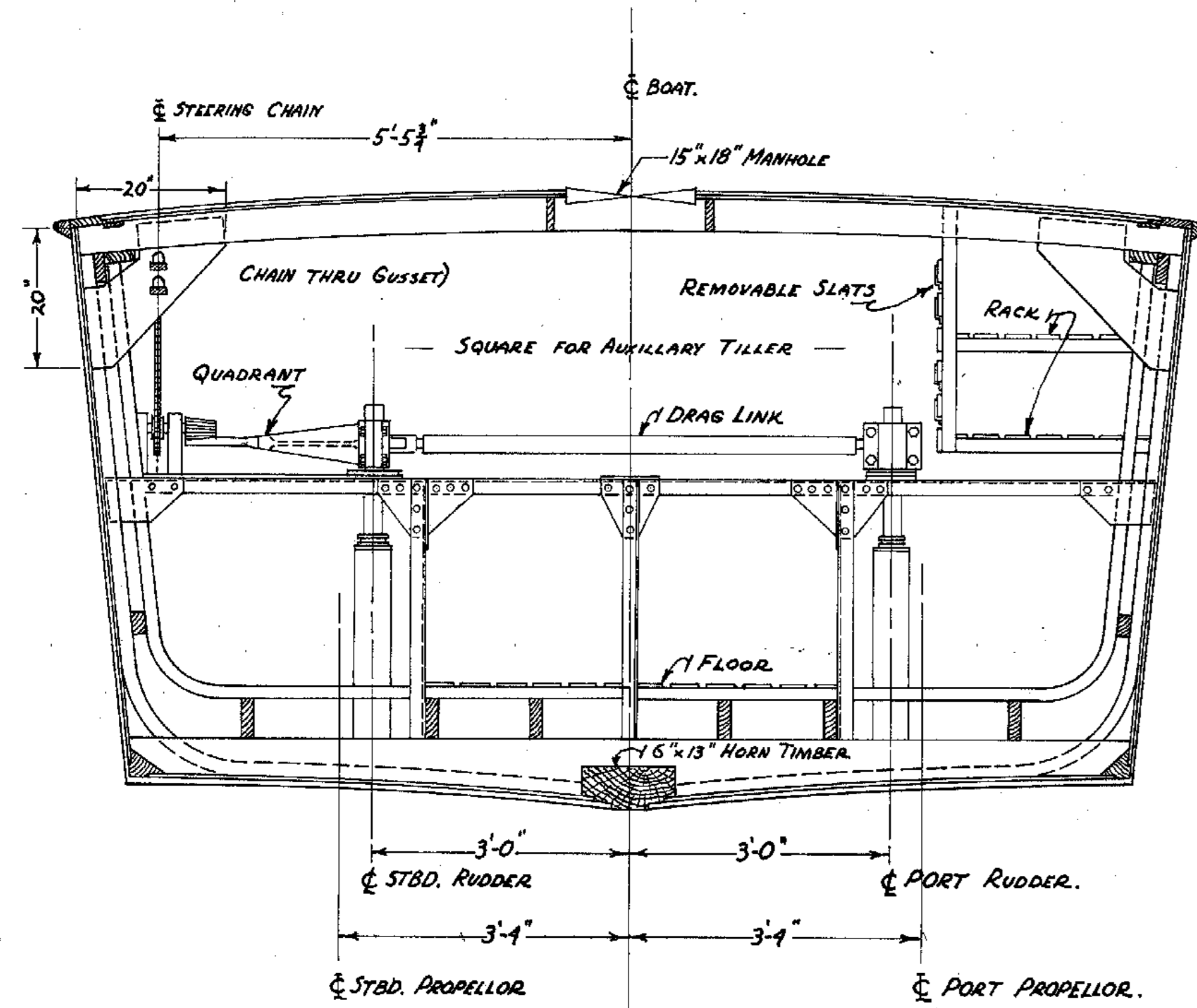
SECTION AT FRAME No 16

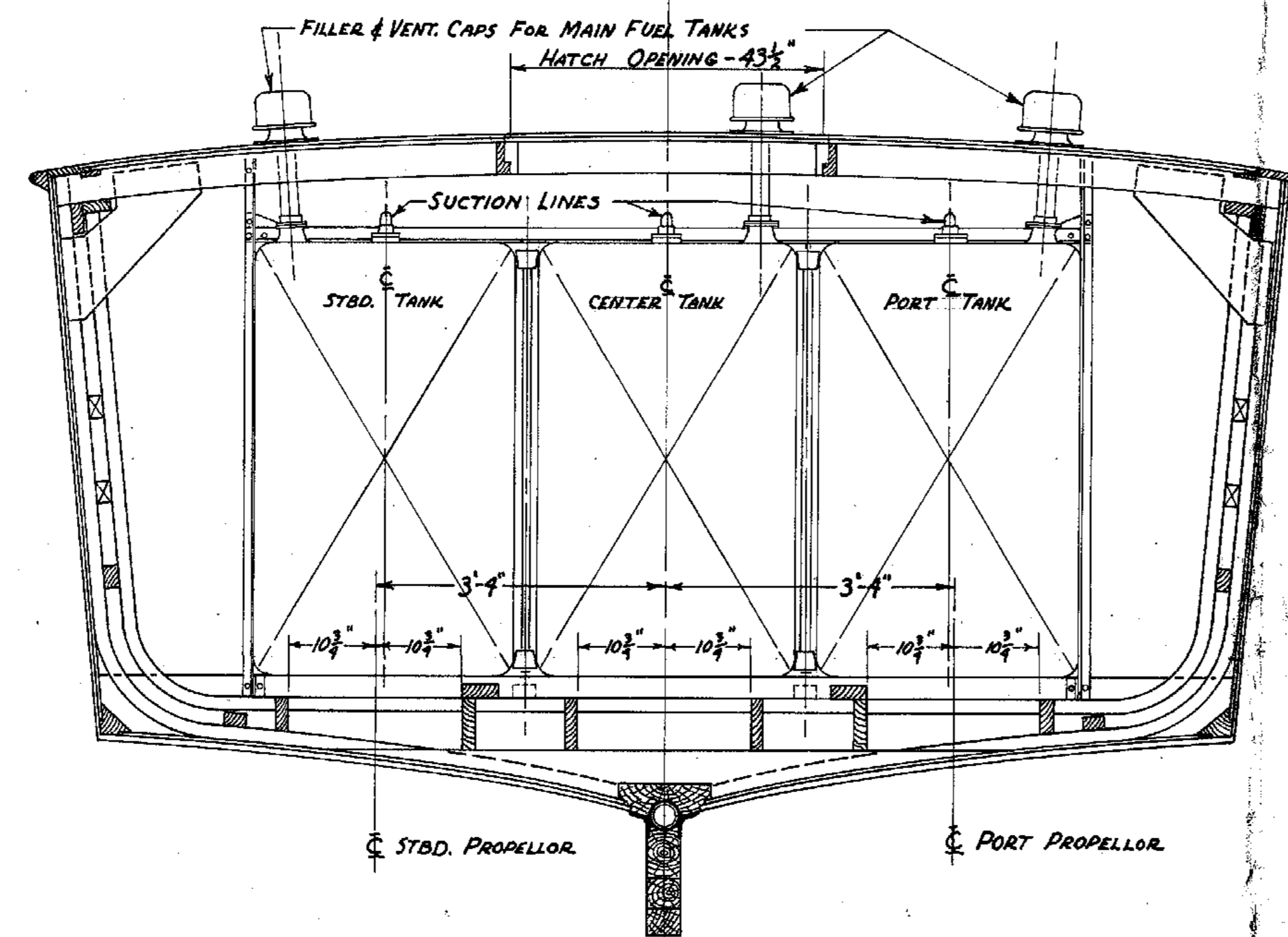
SECTION AT FRAME No 24

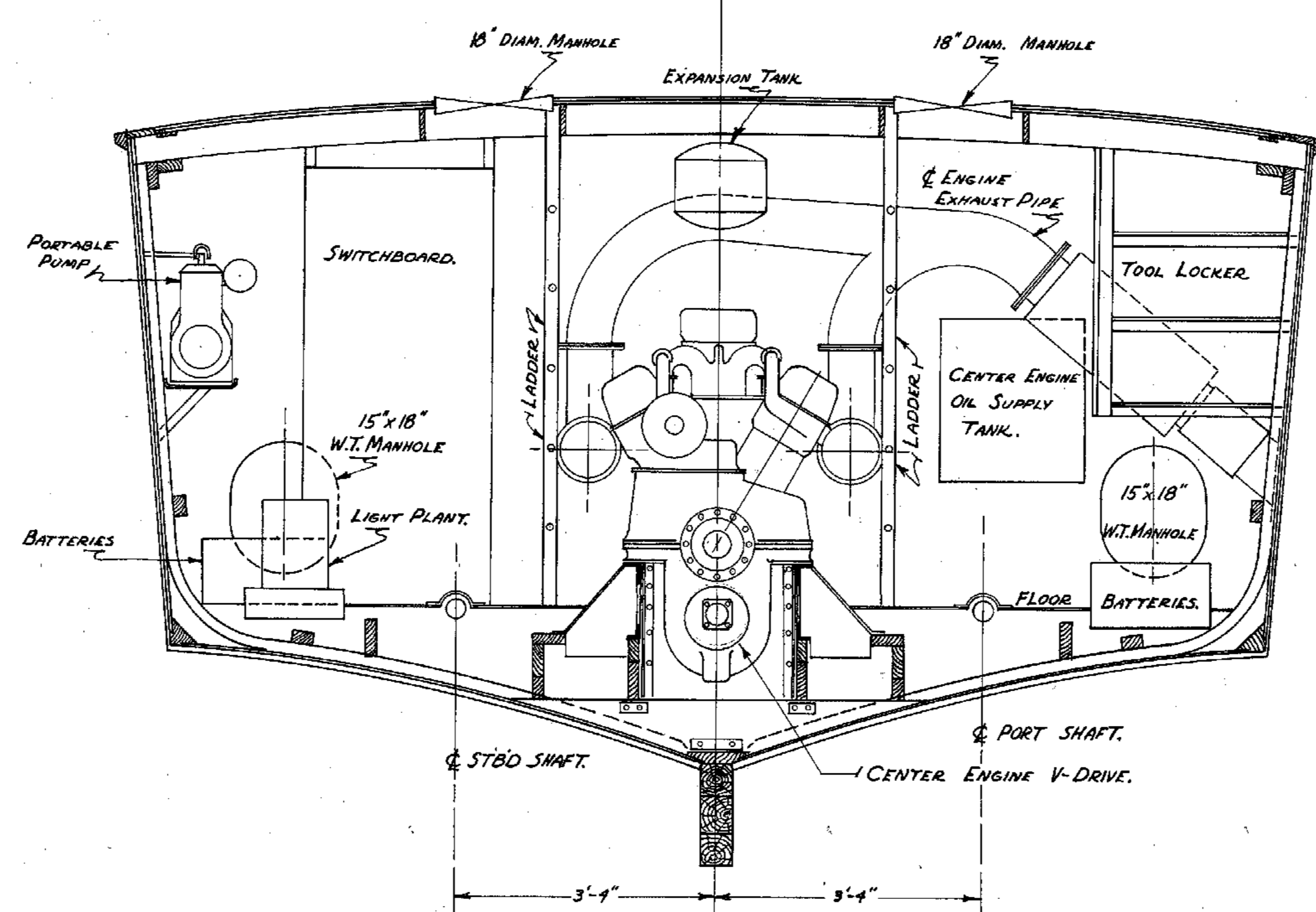

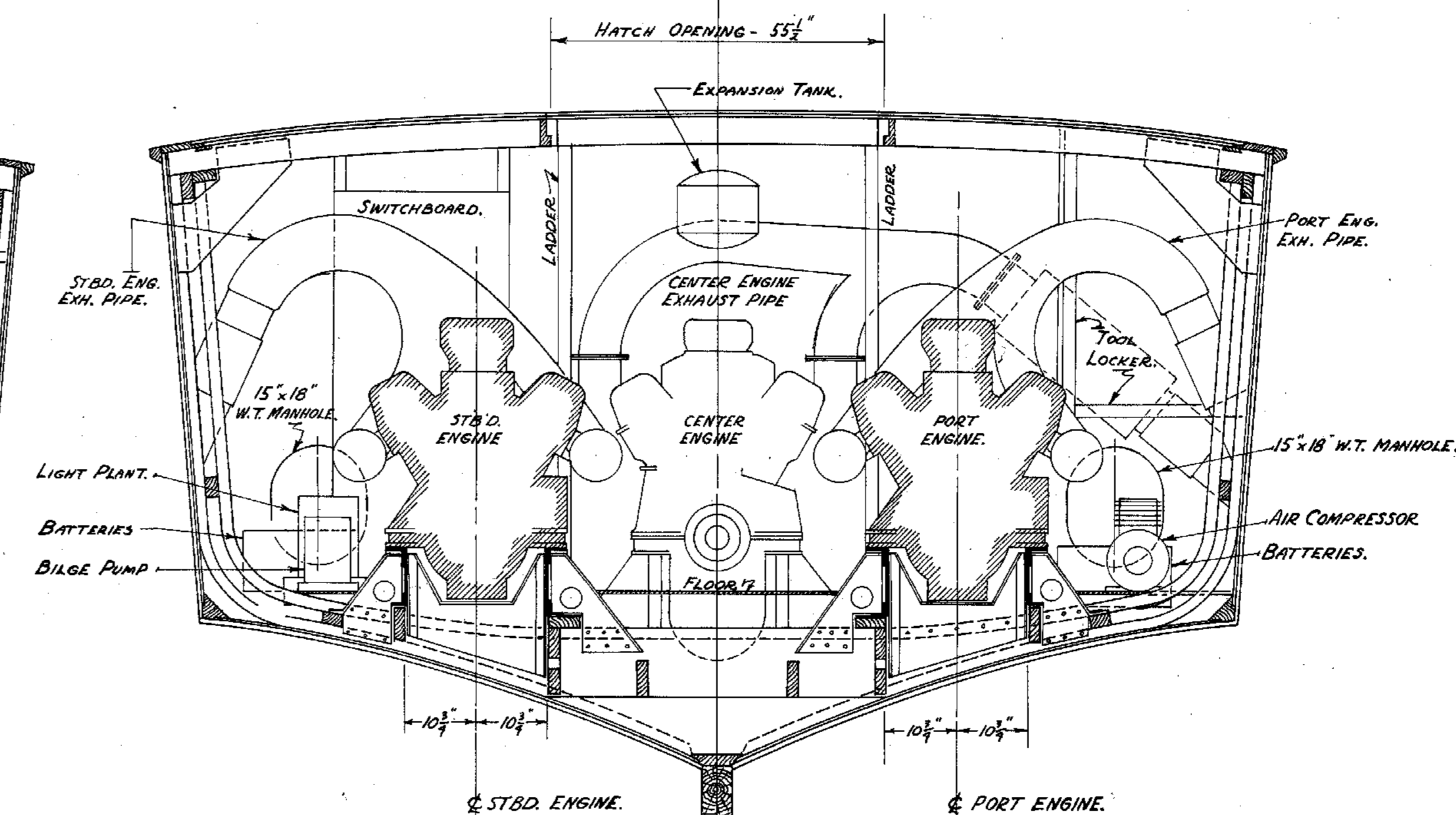
TRANSVERSE SECTION AT FRAME No 74


